

Are the cords and chains of your shading system safe for your child?

Euroblinds, a company sensitive in children's safety and complaint with EU directives proposes the following safety measures for the safety of your children.

- Cords, chains and belts used to operate shading systems must be installed according to specific safety instructions.
- If installation is not carried out according to specific safety instructions there is a risk of strangulation. Keep these instructions for future reference.
- The installation of additional safety devices helps reduce the risk of strangulation.
- Test the safety device regularly.
- Replace the safety device if it is defective.
- Move beds and furniture away from shading systems' cords and chains.
- Existing blinds must be supplied with the appropriate child safety devices and be installed according to the instructions on correct installation.
- Automated shading systems operate without cords, chains and belts and do not pose a risk of strangulation.
